Curriculum for the Week

In math, we will be practicing mental math strategies for adding and subtracting single digit In EL (our reading and writing program) we will continue to learn about what schools are and why they are important using the books *The Dot* and *The Invisible Boy*. For our Letterland unit, we will practice open and closed syllables as we finish unit one and have our test on Tuesday. On Wednesday, we will start unit 2 which will still be working with open and closed syllables, but with some 2-syllable words mixed in.
