I hope everyone had another nice, long weekend. I also hope that everyone made it through the storms without damage or injuries. We were lucky this time for sure! Since we were only in school 2 days last week, our curriculum for this week will be very similar.

Curriculum for the Week

In math, we will be practicing telling whether numbers are even or odd and we will have a test on even and odd on Wednesday. Then we will begin learning mental math strategies for adding and subtracting numbers up to 20. The strategies will include counting on, making a ten, and using a number line. In EL (our reading and writing program) we will be learning about what schools are and why they are important. We will also begin our mclass assessments. These individual assessments are given to see what level students are in reading at the beginning of 2nd grade. It will take me a week or two to get everyone done, but I will send home the results once everyone is finished. For social studies unit, we will continue to learn about good citizenship. Since we didn't get to finish our Letterland unit last week, we will continue to work on the same list in class and for homework. We will have the spelling test on

Tuesday and get the new list of words on Wednesday. At that point, students will need to do the day 1 homework(read words and sentences 2 times)instead of what is listed on the Homework calendar. Thursday will be day 2 homework (Look, Say, Cover, Write).

Homework

Hopefully everyone got their homework done even though we weren't in school since most students had the work at home. If not, work on it along with this week's. For Letterland, Monday will actually be the 6 sentences and Tuesday will not have any Letterland homework. We will be adding in math homework this week as well. If your child is really struggling with an assignment, have them stop after 15-20 min of trying and send me a message or note. I will go over it with them the next day.

Letterland (Spelling)

This may be a change from what your child has done in the past, but it is important that we don't skip any days of Lettlerand or shorten the units, so we have to do it this way.
